Falmouth Road Closures and Parking Park and Ride

- Roads in Falmouth Town Centre will be pedestrianised on Wednesday 10th • First bus will depart Ponsharden at August from 11am to 11pm
- Church Street Car Park will be closed
- Custom House Quay Car Park will be closed all day
- Other car parks will be open as usual
- During the Red Arrows Display, the seafront will be closed to traffic

Town Shuttle Bus

• 60 Townlink operates 9am to 6pm from/to The Moor with the last service leaving The Moor at 5.40pm.

St Mawes Ferry

• The last ferries from Falmouth will leave at 7.15pm and 8.15pm. The last ferry from St Mawes to Falmouth to arrive in time for the display will leave at 4.30pm.

- One bus will run all day
- 9.45am then every 30 minutes
- Last bus departs then National Maritime Museum Cornwall at 6.00pm

Please allow extra time for travelling and use public transport where possible. There will be delays, especially after the display, so why not head into town Craft and ship to enjoy all that movements during the Falmouth has show will be restricted to offer?
