Introduction.

The wide rating bands in IRC 1 and E require an adjustment to the definition of Time Limit Expired for boats in those classes.

Amendments to sailing instructions.

Sailing instructions are amended as follows:

"The Finishing Window is the time for boats in a class to finish after **a given** boat in that class sails the course and finishes. **For IRC 1 and E classes that boat shall be the third boat to finish. For all other classes, that boat shall be the first boat to finish. Boats still racing when the Finishing Window expires, and not subsequently retiring, penalized or given redress, will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE) without a hearing. A boat scored TLE shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the points scored by the last boat that finished within the Finishing Window. This changes RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10."**
