

ATTRACTION INFORMATION THROUGHOUT FALMOUTH

The Pink Wig Parade, Friday 4th August, from 4.30pm at The Greenbank Hotel

Pink wig started with a group of friends coming together in 2009 to wish Sally Hicks Wood well following her breast cancer diagnosis, pending chemotherapy, surgery and radiotherapy treatment.

On this night out 20 of us decided to wear a pink wig for a giggle - as we went to Falmouth pubs, people tried to give us money which we didn't take but it set the seed with our founder Sally for a fundraiser the following year when her first lot of treatment was finished.

So in 2010 about 70 pink wiggers went on a pub crawl armed with Breakthrough Breast Cancer collection tins and raised £1000! In 2011 we got larger and about 150 of us went out again with our pink wigs and raised £2,500! We had become too big for the towns pubs though!

Sally approached Tim Vigus from South West Bars and Events about us holding an event during Falmouth Week - Tim took a gamble on us and it paid off!!! 2012 saw our first 'event' held in the Events Square marquee and our first parade. We raised a whopping £7,700 and Pink Wig Events was formed as a fundraising group.

Since our first event we have had annual fundraisers and it has remained a ladies only night as this is how it started; girls coming together to wish our dear friend well.

Sally sadly passed away in 2014 but we are sure that she would be delighted with how the event has grown over the years and the massive £147,710.00 that has been raised for Breast Cancer Now and The Mermaid Centre at Treliske Hospital. We couldn't do it without the support of those who attend and those who support the event!

We split all funds raised between the two chosen charities Breast Cancer Now for the research element, as this was dear to Sally's heart with her motto being 'until we are all safe'.

We also felt that we needed to donate to our local breast care centre for women and men. We have helped buy tattoo ink for patients that have had breast reconstructions needing nipple tattoos, a 3D monitor for patients to be 'modelled' on how their reconstruction will look. This past year some of our money has contributed to the upgrade of the unit and we have also purchased two picnic benches for staff and patients attending The Cove MacMillan Centre at Treliske.

There are only now five of us on our committee who all give their time voluntarily. We also have our families and friends who volunteer to help us on the night and help make it the success it has become!

This year the parade will start once again from Greenbank Hotel where anyone is welcome. We then head to the Moor and through town to The Waterfront at Church Street Car Park. Women & children can join the parade but the marquee is a ticketed over 18's ladies only night. Tickets can be purchased via our website - www.pinkwigevents.org.uk






