Important Travel Information

Please note, Falmouth will be extremely busy during the week. Please allow extra time for travelling and use public transport where possible. There will be delays, particularly after the Air Display, so why not head into town to enjoy all that Falmouth has to offer?

Falmouth Road Closures and Parking

Roads in Falmouth Town Centre will be pedestrianised during the Pink Wig parade (Friday 9th), the Marching Carnival (Saturday 10th) and the Air Display (Wednesday 14th). Church Street Car Park will be closed for the duration of Falmouth Week. Other car parks will be open as usual. During the Air Display, the seafront will be closed to traffic from 3pm.

Accessible Parking

Please contact the Town Team Office on 01326 313553 to discuss accessible parking options.

Air Display Exclusion Zone

There will be an exclusion zone on the water during the Air Display. No boats or marine craft of any kind may enter the display area during the Air Display. This will be enforced by Falmouth Harbour, the RNLI and PoFSA.

Park & Ride / Float

Park for free in the Ponsharden Car Park and purchase a ticket for the float service from the office. Alternatively, you can catch the usual U1, U2, U3, and U4 First or 69A Go Cornwall bus services from the bus stop outside McDonalds (all with a tap on and tap off payment option). For the return journey, disembark at the Sainsburys bus stop.

Buses & Trains

All services will follow their usual timetables. Please use the Falmouth Docks train station where possible as a managed queueing system will be in place. Falmouth Town station will be closed on Wednesday 14th August.
